Kirk Ziesemer led the meeting in Prayer.

CEMETERY REPORT- Jeffery said he mowed Sat. and Sunday. He got rained out the next day. He was able to mow again on Tuesday and Wednesday and is planning on going out every evening to weed eat and should be done by the weekend. He also trimmed some of the cedar trees.

MINICIPAL COURT- No report. Tamara was not present.

APPROVING OF THE MINUTES- Last month's minutes were looked over and approved. Kim Stulir made the motion to approve, and Kyle Kittley seconded. All in favor.

PUBLIC COMMENTS- Kirk Ziesemer made the comment that the Code Enforcer is making a statement in town. He heard people talking about it at Allsups.

WRITTEN COMPLAINTS- Cindy Rhoads had a complaint about the burnt house across the street from them not being safe and the lot next to it needs to be mowed. The complaint will be given to Manuel, the code enforcer.

CODE ENFORCEMENT REPORT- Manuel sent his report. He tagged 6 more cars and a house on Adams. He has 12 more letters wrote up for this weekend on Public Nuisance. He will have 4 more cars picked up this weekend. One person was fined and has not complied, and the Judge has sent in a Capias Warrant.

PUBLIC WORKS REPORT- Sprayed the park for weeds. Put out 6,200 lbs. of patching material. Tilled the roads at the cemetery, it needs to be sprayed now. Sprayed weeds around town and mowed the sides of the streets. Working on shredding and weed eating the sewer plant. 4 dog citations. The DR brush cutter is at Summits, the shifter cable broke. Replaced tensioner spring on Zero turn. Took 2 dogs to Stamford. The Chlorine Conversion is ending and converting back to Chloramine. Will need to buy one more pallet of patching material.

FIRE DEPT. REPORT- Had a Pickup fire in a wheat field south of town. Tractor pulled down overhead lines and broke the pole at the Intersection of Hwy 380 and 617. Residential smoke alarm north of town, false alarm.

Financials of deposit and approving the bills-Kyle Kittley made the motion to approve and Kimberly Eaton seconded. All in favor.

Put an AD in the newspaper on accepting bids for roof replacement at City Hall. Bids will be for both a Metal bid and a Shingle bid. The bidding will end Tuesday, August 1st by 4:00 PM
