A Special Meeting was called by the City of Rule. The meeting was called to order at 5:31 p.m.

In attendance was Mayor Delle Watkins, Bob Clark, Kimberly Eaton, and Kyle Kittley. Sandy Flores and Krissy Richards were absent. Also in attendance was Hugh Brady and Joyce Ramirez.

Four items were on the agenda.

Opening of sealed bids for the Cemetery Contract that comes up for renewal April 1st, 2022. 3 Bids were submitted. Wade Foreman submitted a bid of \$9600.00, Jeff Pippin submitted a bid of \$ 11400.00 and Jeffrey Murray submitted a bid for 12000.00. The council went with Jeff Pippin due to the experience and references. He does the New Hope cemetery in Stamford along with the rodeo grounds and other places. He has a crew that helps him. Kyle Kittley made the motion to accept Jeff Pippin's bid and Kimberly Eaton seconded. All in Favor.

The sewer pipe size for the Sewer Project was discussed. Jacob and Martin wanted to know what size of pipe we are wanting. 2 wanted 4-inch pipe and 1 wanted 6- inch. The majority of the council choose 4inch. 4-inch pipe passed.

Aspermont Lakeline's were discussed. We will wait to hear from TCEQ to decide what are options are. Either give the lakeline back to Aspermont or make a contract with the City of Aspermont to pay half of all expenses for the lake line, (work and parts).

Donated Youth Money. Kyle Kittley asks the council if he could use some of the Youth donation that was donated. He is starting a youth baseball team. It was agreed to allow him to purchase a pitching machine and catchers equipment. The council agreed to re-imburse him up to \$500.00. It was agreed that equipment bought with this money will be property of the city when the season is over but available to be used when teams are set up. Bob Clark made the motion to re-imburse up to \$500.00, Kimberly Eaton seconded. All in Favor.
