Mayor Delle Watkins led in prayer followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Amanda Shotts gave a presentation of services that are offered through the DSHS. They are putting together grants to service Haskell, Jones, and Stonewall County. These services include Meals on Wheels, mowing of elderly yards and transportation. These services will come out of Haskell. She said they would be going through the community soon to see what services could be used here from visiting with the people.
